ABOUT THE SUMMER INTENSIVE

INTRODUCTION

The New Zealand School of Dance (NZSD) is excited to be offering our inaugural Summer Intensive programme for dancers aged 12 - 17 years.

There will be two streams, where **students elect to participate in their favoured form of dance**, either classical ballet or contemporary dance.

Class size is limited to 25 participants per class.

SOMETHING NEW

The NZSD faculty are preparing three distinct classes daily for participants over the four days. These include technique and repertoire classes daily for both streams.

Classical ballet students can look forward to ***Ballet in Motion***, classes that will focus on different aspects of technical development such as **pirouettes, allegro, musicality and artistry**.

Contemporary dance students can anticipate ***Contemporary Creative***. These classes include **composition and improvisation skills development** as well as yoga as a supportive dance practice.

INFORMAL SHARING

Students will share the repertoire they have been taught over the four days with their peers on the **last day of the Summer Intensive** in an informal setting. Parents are most welcome to drop by too.

REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER INTENSIVE

- Places are limited and **early booking is recommended**.
- Applications will be processed in order of date & time received.
- Students can choose either classical or contemporary technique.
- The timetable structure remains the same daily, Tuesday to Friday and includes the informal studio showing.
- Private lessons are not available.

REGISTRATION FEE & PAYMENT

Registration fee is \$40 which must be paid in addition to course fees. This covers administration costs.

Full payment for the Summer Intensive is expected at the time of enrolment.

Registration opens on Wednesday 5 August 2020 and closes on Sunday 11 October 2020 at 23.59 NZST if not fully booked prior to that date.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

- NZSD will make every possible effort to ensure that the Summer Intensive proceeds in 2021. We do however need to comply with the advice and guidance of the Ministry of Health. In the event that a directive results in the cancellation of the programme, all fees paid by attendees (with the exception of the Registration Fee of \$40) will be fully refunded by the School.
- If an applicant withdraws due to a positive test for COVID-19, the policy on refunds (below) will also apply. This includes after 10 January 2021 where there are genuine extenuating circumstances and a medical certificate must be supplied.



REFUND POLICY:

If due to injury or ill-health it is necessary for a student to withdraw from the course the refund policy is as follows:

- Students withdrawing on or before 10 January 2021 will be entitled to a refund of 80% of the course fees upon presentation of a medical certificate. The registration fee is non-refundable.
- Students withdrawing after 10 January 2021 will not be entitled to a refund except in extenuating circumstances due to ill health when a medical certificate must be supplied.
- If you have enrolled with full payment and a place cannot be made available for you due to over-subscription, all fees paid will be refunded.

Waiver Statement:

Dance training and the athletic exercises associated with it place unusual stress on the body and carry the risk of physical injury. The New Zealand School of Dance will not be liable in any way for injury sustained through participation in classes or related activities. Dance training involves physical 'hands on' adjustment of the student's body by the tutor.

Unless notified to the contrary, it is understood that the parent/guardian grants permission for the management, faculty or staff of the New Zealand School of Dance to authorise any emergency medical care deemed necessary whilst on site.
